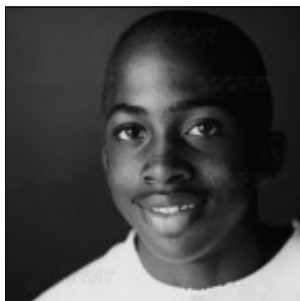

About the Camp

The Brother to Brother camp is sponsored by the Hampton Roads Committee of 200+ Men Inc. It is designed for African American boys ages **13 - 14**. Up to 30 young men will be selected to attend the camp. There will be no cost for those who are selected to attend. The camp will be held on the eastern shore of Virginia at the YMCA Camp Silver Beach facility.

Over the course of the three day period each boy will have a chance to participate in activities like swimming, kayaking, archery etc. The group will also participate in a series of "straight talk" sessions that are designed to address topics such as the importance of an education, goal setting etc... Several prominent African American professionals and business leaders will be invited to address the group and share their stories and important life lessons. The group will also have an opportunity to visit museums of African American history in Baltimore Maryland.

The goal of the camp is to share "important life lessons" with the young men selected to participate as they head into high school. It's never too early for these young men to start thinking about and planning for college. Representatives of the 200+ Men's or-
